Here are a few things to think about when packing your bags to present at the conference.

Bold Colors

Choose one or two bright colors. Do not select a predominantly white outfit, this will wash out your face on camera. Avoid patterns, stage lights can make busy patterns look distracting.

Minimal Jewelry

Limit jewelry, especially anything that could interfere with your microphone or make noise when you move.

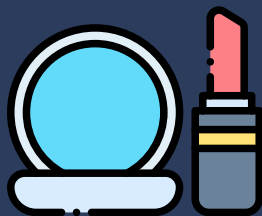

Tech-Friendly Clothes

Pant suits work best for men and women. Jackets have lapels that are great places to clip a microphone and hide the wire to the belt pack without having to adjust wardrobe. Also, pants have belts or sturdy waistbands so there is a place to clip the microphone battery pack. Ladies - dresses are best left for non-presentation days.

Makeup

If you are planning to wear makeup, a heavier application works best under the lights onstage.
