



HANDHELD MICROPHONE TIPS

A few tips to help you sound great and keep your audience engaged from start to finish.

1) PLACEMENT



Hold the microphone 4 to 6 inches from your mouth, below your chin. Point the mic grille toward your mouth.

2) CONSISTENCY



Maintain the same distance consistently throughout your presentation. Once you find a good mic position, consider locking your arm in to your waist to sustain your placement.

3) HANDS OFF



Do not touch or "cup" the microphone grille with your hand.

4) PASS THE MIC, CAREFULLY



If you need to share the mic with another presenter or an audience member asking a question, be mindful of handling noise.
